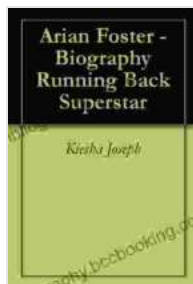

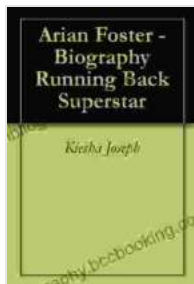
Legacy
