3. If you require extra space to list additional items and terms, attach a separate sheet. All attachments should be signed and dated by both the landlord or the landlord's agent and the tenant to show that both parties have read and agree to the attachments.
4. The landlord or the landlord's agent must give the tenant a copy of the tenanted Agreement and any attachments, two copies of one electronic copy of the compiled condition report and a copy of the Tenant Information Statement published by NSW Fair Trading.


